THE MENTORSHIP PROGRAM

PMP empowers exceptional Palestinian tech entrepreneurs, executives and startups by connecting them to a global network of mentors, from Israel, Europe, the United States, and the Gulf. PMP connects those in the developing Palestinian startup ecosystem with foreign partners, mentors, and companies that have had success in similar endeavors, bridging the gap with foreign markets. Every 6 months, new participants are matched with one or more mentors, who they meet with every two weeks (mainly remotely). Each cycle includes an Orientation & Matching Process and monthly skill building workshops. Mentees will have the opportunity to address key issues in their businesses and build lasting connections with exceptional businesspeople in the Palestinian tech sector and their international counterparts.

PMP is part of the Palestinian Internship Program (PIP), which was founded in early 2014 as a U.S.-registered 501 (c)(3) not-for-profit organization and which has been backed by the U.S. Department of State, USAID, and several U.S. foundations. Current funders for PMP include the US Embassy - Palestinian Affairs Unit.
